In the spirit of the "Toxic Tours", coined and led for years by the Texas Environmental Justice Advocacy Services, the training tour will be designed to educate attendees by highlighting the severity of the petrochemical industry's impact on communities that currently exist, but often goes undiscussed in our movement, and our nation's, discourse. If we are to stand in true solidarity with leaders and communities demanding environmental justice and climate action, we must do a better job at understanding the realities they face.

The tour will be facilitated by two Climate Reality partners at the forefront of demanding the plight of frontline and fenceline communities be understood and that environmental justice be done: the <u>Bullard Center for Environmental Justice</u> and the <u>Port Arthur Community Action Network</u>.

Tour capacity is limited to 100 individuals to avoid overwhelming the local community.
