CLIMATE REALITY LEADERSHIP COMMUNITY TRAINING

TOKYO, JAPAN | 2019 OCTOBER 2-3

The climate crisis threatens the economy, health, and future well-being of Japanese citizens. The Climate Reality Leadership Community training represents a unique opportunity to become a part of the solution to this global problem and help Japan realize a more sustainable future.

Each year, The Climate Reality Project and former U.S. Vice President Al Gore hold multi-day events to educate citizens around the world about the science of climate change, the economic, social, and environmental challenges posed by the climate crisis, and how everyday people can respond.

The Climate Reality Project is proud to have hosted 42 trainings in 13 countries. This training would be the first-ever Climate Reality event in Japan. It comes at a critical time for Japan and its citizens, held after the United Nations Secretary General's Climate Summit, when global attention is turned to Japan as host of the G20 and upcoming 2020 Olympic Games. Meanwhile, the country stands at a crossroads, needing to accelerate to achieve the United Nations' Sustainable Development Goals by pursuing a pathway to renewable energy and de-carbonization of society.

By joining this two-day event in Tokyo, attendees will have the rare opportunity to learn directly from Vice President Gore about how to communicate about the climate crisis persuasively and encourage people everywhere to create change, just as he did in the landmark films *An Inconvenient Truth* and



An Inconvenient Sequel: Truth to Power. Mr. Gore will be joined by field-leading experts eager to share their experiences and knowledge.

Each training features presentations, panel discussions, and skill-building workshops focused on the science of climate change, how to communicate key concepts and issues associated with the climate crisis, and offers guidance on what people can do to help solve the climate problem and achieve sustainable development.

The training is open to the public, free of charge, and will be conducted primarily in Japanese. Simultaneous translation will be available to those who prefer English.

AT A TRAINING, PARTICIPANTS WILL:

- Learn how climate change is and will be impacting Japan, and the strategies for implementing practical clean energy solutions that can promote a safe, healthy, and prosperous future.
- Hear from field-leading experts about the need to strengthen emissions reduction targets and how implementing global best practice to achieve these goals will benefit not only future generations but also business goals right now.
- Gain valuable skills on communicating climate science, motivating colleagues and community members to share their concern about the climate crisis, and find ways to implement their ideas on how to respond to the climate problem.
